# I want to be involved, what do I need to do?

## I am an employer and have a number of employees who need training

1. Contact [andrew.watkins@sportactivensa.co.uk](mailto:andrew.watkins@sportactivensa.co.uk), Project Officer to arrange a visit and talk through the training needs of your organisation. You'd be surprised what else we can help with
2. Complete our state aid document (De Minimus) to ensure your organisation is eligible. You can download this from <http://www.sportactivensa.co.uk/regions/northwest/fundingopportunities>
3. Work with Andrew to decide who needs a qualification, at what level and within what timescale. At this stage you'll be issued with a code and an agreed amount of employees to train utilising the financial assistance
4. Work with Andrew to decide which provider is best suited to your organisation and the most suitable dates for training. Download the latest course schedule from <http://www.sportactivensa.co.uk/regions/northwest/fundingopportunities>
5. Now it's time to book the course. Payment to the provider will need to be made up front. All individuals attending the course will need to apply either direct through <http://www.getqualifiednw.org.uk> or via another method that you and Katie, your Business Development Manager can work through
6. Individuals attend the course
7. As with all funded projects, there is paperwork involved, but we'll streamline it wherever we can. Each employee will need to complete, sign and return to the national skills academy:
  - a. An application form
  - b. An Individual Learner Plan
  - c. A short record document
  - d. Two retention documents
  - e. A bacs form for reimbursement
8. We'll also need you, as the employer to sign the paperwork (b&d) to show you are committed to their development through this programme, but we'll help you through this.

Note: an online facility is available for completing the paperwork via [www.getqualifiednw.org.uk](http://www.getqualifiednw.org.uk), but signatures must be originals made in ink

9. Once employees are successful we will reimburse 60 % of the course cost up to a maximum of £200 per person for level 2 and up to a maximum of £300 per person for level 3 qualification

Note: We underlined successful! That's because reimbursement of qualification can only be made upon the successful completion and passing of the course. The certificate is our evidence they've completed and notice for refund to be made to you. Unfortunately, we can't issue reimbursement for individuals who don't pass the course.

## I am an individual and want to gain a qualification

1. Visit <http://www.sportactivensa.co.uk/regions/northwest/fundingopportunities> and check your eligibility. Download the health and fitness qualification brochure and decide on the qualification you want to gain. Make sure you check any pre-requisites with the relevant provider

Note: You cannot gain a level 3 qualification without the pre-requisite level 2. This is also the case for some of the level 2 qualifications. If this is your first level 2, we recommend you choose the Level 2 certificate in Instructing Fitness, either gym or exercise to music based. This is the basic qualification required to work in the health and fitness arena.

2. Decide which of the providers you want to train with. This decision might be based on location, date of course or overall course price. If unsure give the provider a call and talk to them. However, rest assured that as approved providers for the National Skills Academy they are all quality providers and the best in the region  
Note: We've underlined all as approved academy providers are only approved after a 6-12 month rigorous tendering round where quality control, provision of courses and sector engagement are scrutinised.
3. Once you've decided upon the course and provider book your place with the relevant provider making payment upfront and direct to the provider at this stage

Once booked on the course complete the application form on [www.getqualifiednw.org.uk](http://www.getqualifiednw.org.uk). To do this you will need to know the course title, the course dates, the course price and the course provider you've chosen

Note: your application will be sent to the project team. You will receive notification of receipt, but this doesn't mean you've been accepted onto the funding programme yet. Approximately a month before the course you will receive notification on whether you've been eligible to receive the reimbursement of the course cost. You'll also receive paperwork to manage throughout this programme

4. Attend the course and complete the paperwork! As with all funded projects, there is paperwork involved, but we'll streamline it wherever we can. You will need to complete and sign:
  - a. An application form
  - b. An Individual Learner Plan
  - c. A short record document
  - d. Two retention documents
  - e. A bacs form for reimbursement

We'll also need your employer to sign some paperwork (forms b&d) to show they are committed to your development through this programme. You are responsible for accurate completion, gaining the relevant signatures and sending this paperwork back to the national skills academy. No paperwork, no reimbursement!

5. Upon completing the course you will need to notify us and then send a copy of your final certificate
6. Upon successfully gaining your qualification we will reimburse you with 60 % of the course cost up to a maximum of £200 for your level 2 and up to a maximum of £300 for your level 3. We can only reimburse those who successfully complete the course and the certificate is our evidence of this. Unfortunately, we can't refund individuals who don't pass the course.

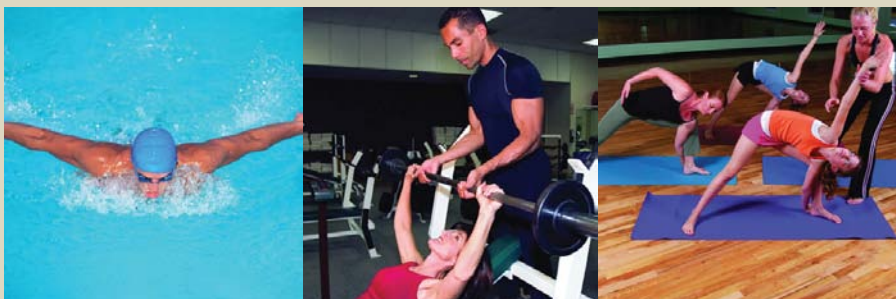
